Our Voice Reach Talking Pendant is the smallest and least obtrusive in the market. Compact and easy to use, the Talking Pendant summons assistance whenever you need it, at any time of the day or night.

It is designed to allow immediate voice contact during an emergency call. Within the signal range (100-150 meters) of the console unit, the simple press of a button can open up two-way voice communication between you and our Emergency Response Centre. The builtin microphone and speaker lets you talk to our nurse right through the pendant like a speaker phone.

Warning for those with pacemakers:

Radiofrequency energy from mobile devices and other technologies, including our LifeGuard SmartMobile, SmartWatch and SmartTracker, may cause interference with pacemakers. In particular, note the following precautions:

- **PROPER STORAGE** avoid placing or wearing them next to the pacemaker. For instance, don't carry your mobile device in your shirt or jacket pocket if it rests near the pacemaker.
- PROPER DISTANCE hold your mobile device to the ear opposite the side of the body where the pacemaker is implanted. Ensure your mobile device remains at least 15 centimetres away from your pacemaker.
